Single Double Turner Lodge:

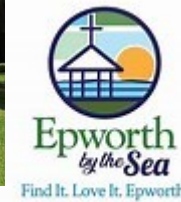
\$ 375.72 single \$ 260.42 double per person

Epworth By the Sea's St. Simons Island campus is approximately one hour from Savannah, GA and Jacksonville, FL, 12 miles from I-95, and 13 miles from Brunswick-Golden Isles Airport (BQK). From U.S. Highway 17, take the F.J. Torras Causeway to St. Simons Island. At the end of the causeway, stay in the left lane and continue north to Sea Island Road. Go straight through the traffic light, staying on Sea Island Road. Turn left at the first street marked Hamilton Road and then right onto Arthur J. Moore Drive to enter Epworth By The Sea.
